Two races will be required to be completed to constitute a series. When fewer than four races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race score. When four or more races have been completed, a boat's serial score will be the total of her race score excluding her worst score.						
Rules	Races will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (RRS), the prescriptions of the RYA, principles and practices of the RYA Racing Charter, and the rules of the Wayfarer Class Association. The RYA Advisory Hearing shall be available. The Exoneration Penalty score is 30% and non-discardable. RSS 44.3 shall not apply.	Disclaimer of Liability	A boat is entirely responsible for her own safety, whether afloat or ashore and nothing, in the notice of race and sailing instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility. It is for the boat to decide if she is 'fit to sail' in the conditions in which she will find herself. By launching the boat confirms she is fit for those conditions and her crew is competent to sail and compete in them. Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the boat, nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred as a result of the boat taking part in racing. The organiser encompasses everyone helping to run the race and the event, and include the organising authority, the race committee, the race officer, rescue boats and beach masters. The provision of rescue boats does not relieve the boat of her responsibility.						
Eligibility	Each helm must be registered as a member of the Wayfarer Class Association and all boats must have a valid Wayfarer Class Certificate of Measurements issued by the UKWA.	Insurance	All entries are required to hold third party indemnity insurance, with a minimum indemnity of two million pounds sterling, or equivalent for the total period for event, and affirm such cover to the organising authority. Entrants not from the UK need to have the accepted Normal Minimum level of liability insurance for their country (this level needs to be displayed to all other competitors).						
Entry	Entry Forms can be obtained from the above contact or from the WSC or UKWA websites. Entry prior to the day is preferred as this will aid the club know if there will be sufficient competitors to run the event. Postal entries should be sent to the contact above.	Entry Limit	40 boats (late entries, please confirm with contact above).						
Entry Fee	£20 per boat including the £3 UKWA levy.	Sailing Instructions	Sailing Instructions will be issued at registration. Boats and equipment may be subject to scrutiny and/or measurement during the event at the discretion of the Race Committee.						
Registration	In the Club House from 08:30 am on Saturday 10 July 2021 or on the Friday evening. All competitors will be required to produce their valid measurement certificate. The clubhouse will be open on Saturday evening (Friday evening is tbc) for competitors and friends.	Briefing	09:45 am Saturday 10 July 2021.						
Covid 19	The club is taking all reasonable precautions to avoid the spread of Covid-19 and asks all competitors to abide with the precautions in place at the time of the event. If Covid-19 precautions result in the event being cancelled the organisers will aim to provide at least 1 weeks' notice.	Camping and Mobile Homes	Free camping is available to all competitors at the back of the club car park. Toilet and shower facilities will be available to campers 24 hours a day in the club house. If over the weekend competitors want a meal at the Maybush they are advised to book this in advance to avoid disappointment.
